2. Players will alternate throws with their opponents. First team to reach 12 points at the completion of the round will win. Innings do not need to be completed. Winning team does not have to win by 2 points.
3. Participants must use cornhole supplies provided by the Corporate Challenge staff.
4. Scoring will be three points for an "in the hole" and one point for each bag "in the count." "Cancellation Scoring" will be used. **Only one team will score on each throw.**
5. Foul bags must be removed from the pit. If any foul bags knock off any "in play" bags, the "in play" bags must be returned to original space.
6. Time limit for each match is 10 minutes. In the event of a tie score at the end of time, additional rounds will be played until a team scores points. There will be no time limit for Championship match.
7. Substitution may only occur after a match has ended.
8. Match will start with a coin toss . Winner determines their side or toss first. No moving sides once match begins.
9. Non-alcohol event.

Scrabble

PARTICIPANTS:

Competition will consist of two players from each team. Only employees can participate and must be registered through ActiveNet.

RULES:

1. Participants must check-in between 4:30 p.m.– 4:45 p.m.
2. Substitutions will only be allowed at the completion of each match.
3. The player drawing a letter nearest to the beginning of the alphabet plays first. A blank tile supersedes all others.
4. Each scrabble match will have a 20-minute time limit. The team that is ahead when time is called will be the winner. If a player has already placed a letter on the board as a move before time expires, they may complete that final move as long as there is no delay in the placement of the remaining letters.
5. The final score shall be the team's accumulated points minus the points from the remaining tiles in their hand.
6. Words that are challenged by an opponent must appear exactly as submitted in the Scrabble Dictionary. If the challenge is successful, the player must remove tiles and forfeit turn. If challenge is unsuccessful, the player challenging will forfeit their turn.
7. A player has a maximum of two minutes to take his/her turn. If a player does not make a move within two minutes, the turn is forfeited.
8. A player may use the turn to exchange some or all tiles. This move ends their turn.
9. Once tiles are placed on the board, they may not be removed or replaced.
10. A bingo is a play made using all seven tiles from a player's hand. These grant a bonus of 50 points to a player that has achieved this.
11. Teammates may not sit side by side and may not coach each other during play. Coaching may result in disqualification.

SCORING:

Scrabble is part of the Game Night event. All individual events will be scored with points; every point counts towards the team's overall point total. The team with the most individual event points will be declared the winner of Game Night and will be awarded the event plaque at the Closing Ceremony.

AWARDS:

9. Checking and raising are allowed. Maximum of three raises per bet.
10. Misdeals are dealt over.
11. All playing money must remain on the table at all times.
12. No coaching from spectators.
13. Players may not share money or give team members money.
14. If a player has money, they must continue to play (**you cannot hold money**).

RULES: CIF rules will be used (except where local rules conflict).

1. Participants must check-in 15 minutes before their team's printed start time.
2. All teams must wear same colored, numbered jerseys during game play. Teams should provide two jerseys or a two colored reversible (1 for "home" and 1 for "away" games).
3. Games are full court and consist of two, 10-minute halves with running time.
4. A regulation clock will be used for the last minute of 2nd half, if score is within 10 points.
5. Players will get a max of four fouls per game before being disqualified for remainder of game.
6. Any player or coach ejected from a game will be disqualified from all other basketball games.
7. Time-Outs: Teams will be given a maximum of one time-out per half. Teams will be given a maximum of one time-out per overtime period.
8. Overtime Periods: First overtime period shall be a two-minute running clock. After the first overtime period, each additional overtime period shall consist of a one-minute running clock.
9. Team Captains must submit a line-up card with a maximum of ten players to the scorekeeper five minutes prior to game time. A new line-up card may be submitted before each game, which may only include original 10. Line-up changes will not be permitted once a game has started.
10. All referee calls are final.
11. For a player to be eligible to play on **Tuesday, May 9**, they must have played in a minimum of one game on **Tuesday, May 2**
12. **NO DUNKING! NO HORNS!**
13. Non-alcohol event.

2. A coin toss will determine who breaks. Regardless of which ball is pocketed, the breaker may choose **stripes or solids**.
3. Table remains "open" until first ball is pocketed legally.
4. Jump shots or illegally touching a ball is not permitted.
5. Coaching is not permitted, except amongst Coed teammates.
6. The penalty for a scratch is a loss of turn. Scratch balls are played behind the line and must cross over the line before contacting any rail or ball.
7. If a player pockets the cue ball when attempting the eight ball, he/she loses the game.
8. Scratching on a break will result in a loss of turn.
9. Slop is allowed; except on the eight ball.
10. Players must call their pocket before shooting the eight ball, whether obvious or not.
11. Substitution may only occur after a match has ended.




Billiards

How to Rack: To begin the game of 8-ball, the 15 colored balls are placed randomly in a triangle, called a “rack.” The base of the rack is parallel to the short end of the pool table and is positioned so the ball in the tip of the rack is located on the center of the foot spot. The balls in the rack are pressed together tightly to acquire a solid rack, and remain in contact after the rack is removed. Within the rack, the 8-ball is centered, while the two corners are occupied by the two opposite groups (one solid ball and one striped ball). The game begins with the cue ball in hand placed anywhere behind the head string. The head string is the quarter of the billiard table farthest from the rack, or an area also commonly referred to as the “kitchen.”

PARTICIPANTS:

During the Coed tournament, a minimum of two females must be on the court at all times (for a full team). Roster can have a maximum of 12 players. If a team is short players, a minimum of 5 players is needed to begin play; of which, two must be female. Maximum of six players on the court. **All participants on roster can participate.** All participants must be registered through ActiveNet.

RULES: CIF rules will be used (except where local rules conflict).

1. Participants must check-in 15 minutes prior to game time.
2. All teams must wear same colored, numbered shirts.
3. Teams must provide a volunteer line judge.
4. A game will be the best of three sets.
5. Rally scoring is used. Any team can score a point regardless of which team served the ball.
6. First 2 games will play to 15 points. In the event of a third game, it is played to 11 points. Must win by 2 points.
7. Team Captains must submit a line-up card with a maximum of 12 players to the scorekeeper 5 minutes prior to game time. Maximum of 6 players allowed on the court at one time.
8. All referee calls are final.
9. Substitutes may be called by the team in possession of the ball.
10. Any player or coach ejected from a game will be disqualified from all other volleyball games.
11. Time-Outs: Teams will be given a maximum of one 30 second time-out per set.
12. No horns.
13. No liberos.
14. Non-alcohol event.
15. Only water is allowed in the gym.
16. Net height will be 7 feet, 6 inches.
17. Team must bring their own warm-up ball.
18. For a player to be eligible to play on **Thursday, May 11**, they must have played in a minimum of one game on **Thursday, May 4**.
