

MLS ILLEGAL BAT RULES

* **ALL BATS MUST HAVE AN ASA STAMP** * to be eligible for play.

NO STAMP - NO PLAY - Before purchasing a bat please look for this stamp:



- **SECONDLY:** The ASA periodically and randomly tests samples of bat models bearing the ASA approved certification mark to verify compliance with the ASA bat performance standards. Meaning occasionally **even a stamped bat may be deemed ILLEGAL**. Please refer to the ASA Website's list of APPROVED bats to verify legal status: WWW.ASASOFTBALL.COM click on "Certified Equipment".
- **FURTHER:** All bats must comply with the S.C.M.A.F. rulebook, Rule 1, Sec. 27. If a make, model, or ASA stamp cannot be determined due to wear & tear **OR** if the Umpire or League Director suspect modification of any kind, he/she may remove it from play. **NO BASEBALL, YOUTH or LITTLE LEAGUE BATS ALLOWED EVER.**

* **IN ADDITION MEN MAY NOT USE THE FOLLOWING BATS IN COED PLAY***

- **ALL FASTPITCH COMPOSITES** (effective SPRING 2010)
- **ALL MIKEN MODELS** (Freaks, NRG's, Ultra's, Maniac, Recoil, Halo, etc.)
- **ALL EASTON COMPOSITES** (Stealth, Synergy, Quantum, etc.)
- **ALL WORTH COMPOSITES** (Mayhem, Wicked, Mutant, EST, Hybrids, etc.)
